

LSVR Risk & Fire Assessment
Guidance

Using the guidelines suggested below please consider what risks there are to those people setting up/ dismantling, manning and members of the public attending your stand.

<u>Hazard</u>	<u>Who's at risk</u>	Control measure to minimise the risk
Look for hazards which you could reasonably expect to result in significant harm under the conditions in the workplace.	List groups of people that might be affected	What control measures are in place to prevent the hazard you have listed

Examples of hazards

- Slipping & tripping
- Fire (from flammable material)
- Covid - 19
- Chemical (battery acid)
- Moving parts
- Working at height
- Ejection of materials
- Pressure systems
- Vehicles
- Electricity
- Dust
- Fumes
- Manual Handling
- Noise
- Poor lighting
- Low temperature

Examples of who's at risk

- Operational staff
- Contractors
- People sharing your workspace
- Members of public

Examples of control measures

- Meet the standards set by legal reequipment
- Comply with recognised industry standard
- Represent good practise
- Reduce the risk as reasonably possible
- Have you provided adequate information, instruction or training adequate systems or procedures?
- If so, then risks are adequately controlled but you need to indicate the precautions you have taken

Further action

What more could you reasonably do for those risks which were not adequately controlled?

You will need to priority to those risks which may affect large numbers of people or could result in serious harm.

Principles for further action

- Removed risk completely
- Try a less risky option
- Prevent access to the hazard
